something. 😊 But, since you said you could make copies and get them back to me I am wasting no time. I don't need the magazines back just copies of the articles.

Also, when Bree comes back I'll see about getting you a free subscription to PWA Newline. Do you have a middle name? I could have the subscription put in your middle name? Bree has taken a six week medical leave -- AIDS! Hopefully, he will get well soon. I think he was just burnt out too! You know how exhausting this work can be.

I did talk to Jackie early this week. Sad to say, she is way behind and probably will always be behind. As you are very well aware, she doesn't have a 9-5 job.
